### **Stamp Out Stigma Kits**

### 1 - 4 Oct 2009

Since President S R Nathan launched Silver Ribbon (Singapore) on 4 Feb 2006, we hold at least 2-3 mental health events monthly through innovative means. To commemorate World Mental Health Day yearly, we collaborate with different organisations to organise a list of activities.

This year, we packed **10,000** Stamp Out Stigma kits with the help of more than 80 volunteers from Singapore Soka Association, ranging from youths to senior citizens.

The objectives of those kits are to encourage the public to

- learn more about mental health,
- talk openly about mental illness, and
- support organisations that help to drive away stigma against mental illness.













## World Mental Health Day – Street Festival @ Cheng Yan Place 10 Oct 2009

This event was organised by Health Promotion Board of Singapore and the World Mental Health Day 2009 Committee, chaired by Ms Porsche Poh, Founder/Executive Director, Silver Ribbon (Singapore). Mr Hawazi Daipi (Senior Parliamentary Secretary, Ministry of Manpower & Ministry of Health, was invited to be the Guest of Honour.

Silver Ribbon (Singapore) participated in a street festival, alongside with other mental health organisations. In addition, we distributed the Stamp Out Stigma kits to the public and presented prizes & plaques to the winners of Champion of Mental Health Award under the individual and organisation category respectively, open to

#### Individuals who


- is coping with his/her mental illness positively; or

- actively support mental health events in the community


Besides a skit on Dementia and laughter therapy, Dr Fatimah launched *Teacher! Teacher! I Love You!* written by a consumer named Harris Ng, who has been coping positively with Schizophrenia for more than 30 years.

"Teacher Teacher I Love You" by Harris Ng talks about the educational system in a friendly story-telling way. The book leads ultimately to the need for Mental Wellness in the educated mind.

Harris first wrote about the Mental Mind in his book *Recovered Grace: Schizophrenia*. The book written in English has been translated into Chinese, Malay and Korean and is also available in Braille. Harris wrote his second book on the Spirit Mind *When I First Walked In* is now going through the editing process. His third book *Teacher Teacher I Love You*, talks about the third component of a wholesome human being: the Educated Mind.
